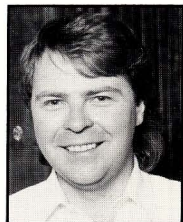

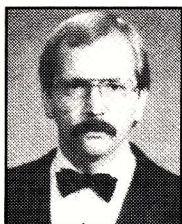
▼ David O. Henderson - *Concert Choir Director*

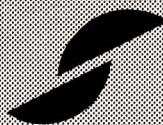

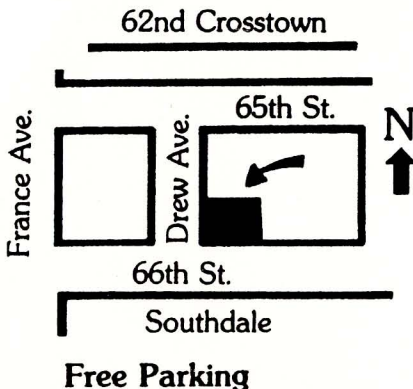

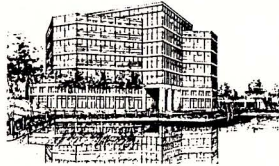
