PRODUCTION STAFF

DR. ROBERT PETERSON - Concert Choir Director

Robert has been Director of Choral Activities at Edina High School for twenty years. He has also directed several musicals at Edina High School - "Mame," "No, No Nanette," "Gypsy," "Guys and Dolls," "Oklahoma," "How to Succeed in Business Without Really Trying," "The Fantasticks," "The Music Man," and "Fiddler on the Roof." Dr. Peterson completed his PhD in music at the University of Minnesota. He was also director of the Varsity Men's Chorus at the University. In the past he has directed choirs and musicals in the Armed Forces Overseas Schools in Japan, Germany, and Belgium. His professional singing has taken him to the Edgewater Inn, Schicks Cafe, the St. Paul House in Shakopee, McGuire's Inn in St. Paul, and the Golden Valley Country Club.

DR. DAVID O. HENDERSON - Pit Orchestra Director

David came to Edina from an active singing and teaching schedule. Over the past few years he has taught many of the Concert Choir members. Henderson maintains an active singing career in the Twin Cities, including solo appearances with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, Minnesota Chorale, and the Dale Warland Singers. David came to the Twin Cities after singing for several years in New York with the Waverly Consort, Gregg Smith Singers and the Norman Luboff Choir. David has completed his Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Minnesota and is pursuing more solo work nationally.

JOHN COMMAND - Choreographer

John returns to the Edina stage for his 12th Current Jam. His most recent professional work as a choreographer is the hit production of *Crazy for You* at the Chanhassen Dinner Theater. John's last musical at Edina was "Mame." Since then, John has choreographed the 1988 Super Bowl Pre-Game Show, as well as the Disney film, *Newsies*. He also did the choreography for the films, *Sleepless in Seattle*, and Prince's, *Purple Rain*. His television credits include *The Golden Girls*, *Evening Shade*, *Perfect Strangers*, *Step by Step*, and *Getting By*. 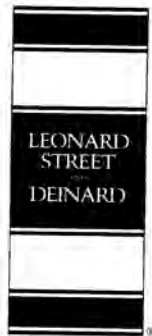
