## **Production Staff**

### **John Command, *Choreographer***

John returns to the Edina stage for his 17th Current Jam. He also choreographed *Bel Canto* for Happenin' '01. His most recent work was as director of "Sweet Charity" at Bloomington Community Theater and he will return there next year to do "Gypsy" and "Chicago". This summer he will be directing "Crazy For You" at Mound Community Theater. John's last musical at Edina was "Mame". Since then he has choreographed the 1988 Super Bowl Pre-Game Show, the Disney film "Newsies", "Sleepless in Seattle" and Prince's "Purple Rain". His television credits include "The Golden Girls", "Evening Shade", "Perfect Strangers", "Step By Step" and "Getting By". We are very happy to welcome John back to Edina: the students have enjoyed working with this talented choreographer.

### **Dr. David O. Henderson, *Director***

David came to EHS from an active singing and private teaching schedule. He has appeared with many Twin Cities groups, including solo appearances with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, Minnesota Orchestra and the Plymouth Music Series Ensemble Singers. He arrived in the Twin Cities after singing for several years in New York with the Waverly Consort, Gregg Smith Singers and the Norman Luboff Choir. He received a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Minnesota. When not working at school, he can be found at home in Edina with his wife Kris and their three children Ryan, 7, Erin, 5, and Megan, 2.

### **Dr. Robert Ouren, *Back up Band Director***

Bob is currently instrumental instructor at FAIR School. He taught at Edina High School from 1991-2000. Bob earned his undergraduate degree from Winona State University and his Masters and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Minnesota. He studied conducting with Dr. Barry Kopetz, Dr. Richard Lindner, Donald Schleiker, Mallory Thompson, H. Robert Reynolds and Elizabeth Green. He also studied trumpet with Dr. Richard Lindner, Dr. David Baldwin and Gary Bordner of the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra. He lives in Edina with his wife, Karen, 19-year-old daughter Karissa, and 13-year-old son Matthew.

### **Scott Fahy, *Production Consultant***

Scott is responsible for the sound system, lighting design, video production and the audio recording of Current Jam. Scott has worked with The Bodeans, Widespread Panic, 10,000 Maniacs, Sounds of Blackness, Freddie Jones Band, Cece Winans, Johnny Lang, John Michael Montgomery, Pam Tillis, The Blenders, Patti Lovless, Vince Gill, Bryan White, Shania Twain, and numerous local and regional acts. He is president of Omni Productions, a full service production management firm. This is his 13th year with Current Jam.

### **Diana J. Leland, *Varsity Choir Director***

Diana has taught choral music for a total of twenty-eight years of which twenty-four have been with Edina Schools. She also serves as Edina Schools' Teaching and Learning Specialist for Art and Music. She returned to Edina High School from Valley View Middle School in September, 1999 to direct the Varsity Choirs. Diana was the first director of the Edina HS Varsity Choir from 1975-80. She served the American Choral Directors Association as State President of Minnesota (1979-81), North Central Division President (1984-86) and National President (1989-91). In 1997 she was one of ten teachers selected to receive the Ashland Inc. Teacher Achievement Award for Excellence in Teaching. From 1980-83, Ms. Leland was engaged as General Manager for the Dale Warland Singers, a professional chorus based in the Twin Cities. Currently she serves as one of 24 board members of the International Federation for Choral Music and is actively involved as an executive officer in the planning for the Sixth World Symposium on Choral Music which will be held in Minneapolis from August 3-10, 2002.

### **Andrew Thompson, *Arranger***

Andy is a graduate of Edina High School and has been involved in Current Jam for the past six years. In addition to CJ he has written and arranged for the theater, feature films, chamber groups, orchestras, jazz bands, rock bands and many other ensembles. Next year he will be a senior at the University of Michigan where he studies music composition and percussion.

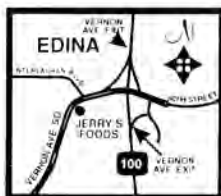

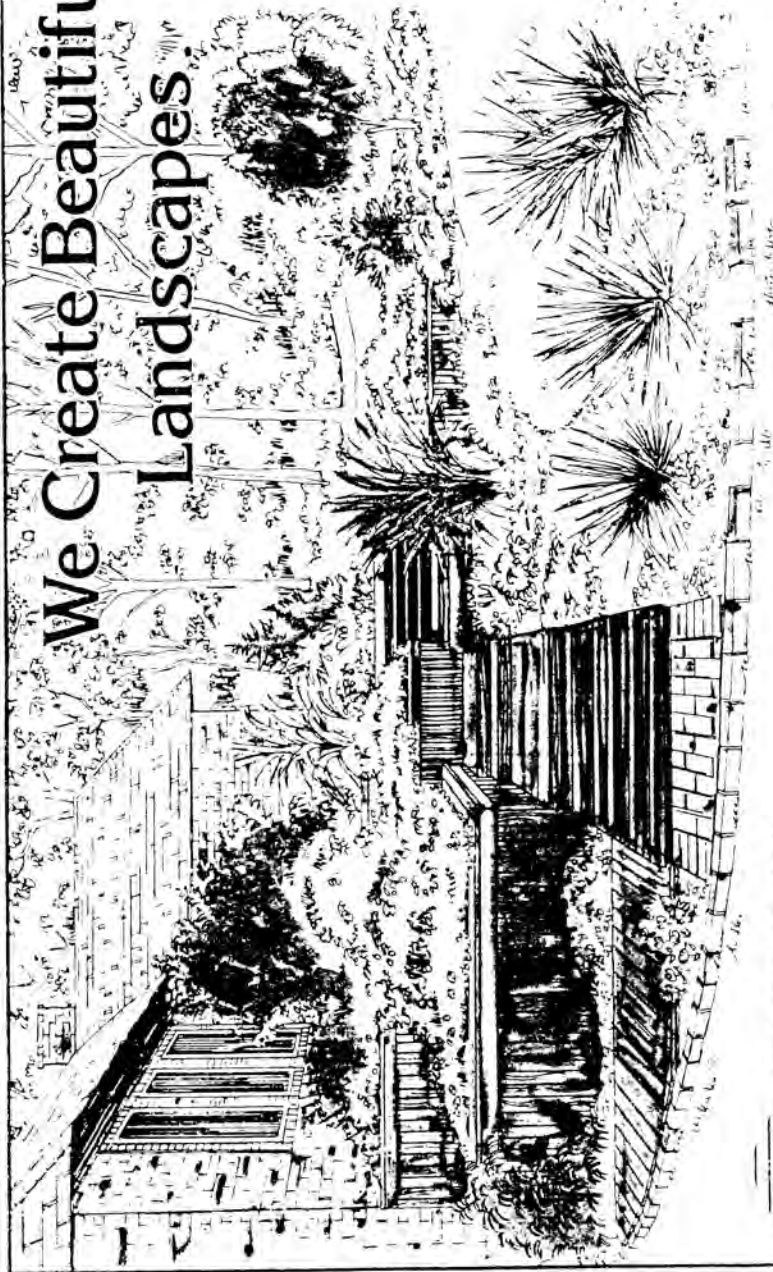

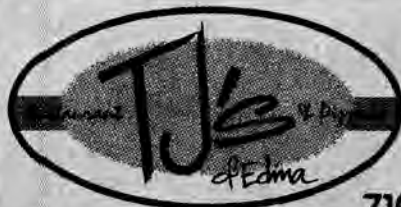
