## Production Staff

### **John Command, *Choreographer***

John returns to the Edina stage for his 18th Current Jam. His most recent work was as director of "Gypsy" at Bloomington Community Theater and he will return there next year to do "Jekyll & Hyde", "West Side Story", and "Evita". This summer he will be directing "How To Succeed..." with the Actors Theater of Minnesota to be presented at the Fitzgerald Theater in St. Paul next September. John's last musical at Edina was "Mame". Since then he has choreographed the 1988 Super Bowl Pre-Game Show, the Disney film "Newsies", "Sleepless in Seattle" and Prince's "Purple Rain". His television credits include "The Golden Girls", "Evening Shade", "Perfect Strangers", "Step By Step" and "Getting By". We are very happy to have John back at Edina and the students have enjoyed working with this talented choreographer.

### **Dr. David O. Henderson, *Director***

David came to Edina from an active singing and private teaching schedule. He has appeared with many Twin Cities groups, including solo appearances with the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, Minnesota Orchestra and the Plymouth Music Series Ensemble Singers. He came to the Twin Cities after singing for several years in New York with the Waverly Consort, Gregg Smith Singers and the Norman Luboff Choir. He received a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Minnesota. When not working at school he can often be seen in his front yard in Edina playing with his wife Kris and their three children Ryan, 8, Erin, 6 and Megan, 3.

### **Dr. Robert Ouren, *Back up Band Director***

Bob is currently instrumental instructor at FAIR School. He taught at Edina High School from 1991-2000. Bob earned his undergraduate degree from Winona State University and his Masters and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Minnesota. He studied conducting with Dr. Barry Kopetz, Dr. Richard Lindner, Donald Schleiker, Mallory Thompson, H. Robert Reynolds and Elizabeth Green. He also studied trumpet with Dr. Richard Lindner, Dr. David Baldwin and Gary Bordner of the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra. He lives in Edina with his wife Karen, 20 year old daughter Karissa and 14 year old son Matthew.

### **Scott Fahy, *Production Consultant***

Scott is responsible for the sound system, lighting design, video production and the audio recording of Current Jam. Scott has worked with Sonic Flood, Rebecca St. James, The Bodeans, Widespread Panic, 10,000 Maniacs, Sounds of Blackness, Freddie Jones Band, Cece Winans, Johnny Lang, John Michael Montgomery, Pam Tillis, The Blenders, Patti Lovless and numerous local and regional acts. He is president of Omni Productions, a full service production management firm. He is also working on productions with Mac Hammond Ministries at Living Word Christian Center. This is his 14th year with Current Jam.

### **Diana J. Leland, *Varsity Choir Director***

Diana has taught choral music for a total of twenty nine years of which twenty five have been with Edina Schools. She is also Edina Schools' Teaching and Learning Specialist for Visual Arts and Music. She returned to Edina High School from Valley View Middle School in September 1999 to direct the Varsity Choirs. She has served as state, division and national president for the American Choral Directors Association as well as the General manager for the Dale Warland Singers. Currently, she is involved in the planning and staging of the Sixth World Symposium on Choral Music which will be held in Minneapolis August 3-10, 2002.

### **Andrew Thompson, *Arranger***

Andy is a composer, arranger and multi-instrumentalist with a diverse background and varied musical interests. A recent graduate of the University of Michigan School of Music, he has studied composition and arranging with Erik Santos, Michael Daugherty, James Aikman and Ellen Rowe. During college he was also a very active performer, playing in both the University Symphony Orchestra and Jazz Ensemble, as well as the UM Percussion Ensemble, Afro-Cuban and Brazilian groups, the Caribbean steel band Panchita and Quartex, a nationally-touring experimental jazz combo led by composer/pianist Stephen Rush. As a composer, Andy's music has been featured on NPR's "All Things Considered" and "The Todd Mundt Show" as well as in the independent feature film Jerome's Razor, which was premiered at the IFP Film Market in New York City in September of 2001. Right now Andy is concurrently pursuing music on both classical and popular fronts, working on pieces for, among others, the University of Michigan Jazz Ensemble, Minneapolis' own Lyndale School, and his rock band, which recently performed at the 2002 International Pop Overthrow Festival.

### **Grant Ashling, Ben Franske & Eric Lewis**

Grant, Ben and Eric are graduates of Edina High School. These three young men come back to work on Current Jam after having been a part of the Edina Technical Theater crew while in high school. 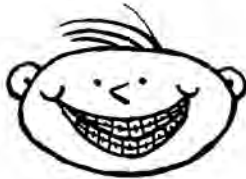

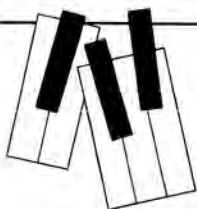
