Fine Arts Department

CHOIR

More than 500 students sing in the Edina High School Choral program, a department comprised of seven curricular choirs meeting during the day, four extra-curricular ensembles providing students an additional singing opportunity outside the school day, and an early-morning, weekly Men's Chorus open to all male singers in the high school and local community. The curricular choirs include 9th Grade SSA (soprano/alto), 9th Grade TTB (tenor/bass), Varsity SSA (soprano/alto, grades 10-12), Varsity TTB (tenor/bass, grades 10-12), Bel Canto (advanced soprano/alto, grades 10-12), Cantemus (advanced tenor/bass, grades 10-12) and Concert Choir (advanced mixed chorus, grades 11-12). A close partnership between middle and high school programs ensures the development of comprehensive, lifelong musical skills for all singers.

BAND

The Edina High School band program consists of more than 500 students in grades 9 through 12. There are five high school concert bands: a concert band, two sections of varsity band, one section of a symphonic band, two sections of 10th grade bands, and four sections of 9th grade band. The 10-12 graders form the Edina "Hornet" Marching Band in the fall. There are 6 extra-curricular jazz bands, two pep bands, and numerous excellent chamber ensembles. Auditions are held annually for placement in all the high school bands. Musical ability and grade level, along with a strong desire to achieve excellent musical results, are the primary factors in determining placement in bands.

ORCHESTRA

The Edina High School Orchestra Program consists of four orchestras across grades 9-12. The curricular ensembles include two sections of 9th grade Repertory Orchestra, Sinfonia Orchestra, Varsity Orchestra and Concert Orchestra. Select students from the EHS Concert Band team up with the Concert Orchestra once a week to dive into symphonic works for full orchestra. Auditions are held at the end of each year for our Varsity and Concert Orchestra. Two extra curricular audition based chamber orchestras meet outside of the school day for grades 9-10 and 11-12. Repertory and Concert Orchestras will team up to perform a side by side concert in conjunction with the elementary and middle school orchestra programs. This collaboration creates a welcoming transition as students cross the bridge from middle school and high school.

THEATRE

Combining the collaborative forces and talents of directors from the Choir, Orchestra, FACS and Theatre departments, the EHS Thespians is the umbrella title for the Edina High School Theatre Program. At its core, we are a group of educators, students, parents, alumni, and community members who believe in the power of the theatre arts to change and improve the lives of young people. We believe in helping ALL adolescents to find their voice and we believe in helping our community to tell their multiple and diverse stories. At the heart of our program is the class THEATRE FOR ALL which pairs students from our Special Education program with students from our performing arts classes to produce a musical for public performance. Besides curricular classes, the EHS Thespians produce multiple extra-curricular offerings each year including a Fall Musical, One Act Play (for competition), Spring Play, and 24 Hour Play Festival.
