PROGRAM NOTES

The Choral Music Department of Edina Senior High School attempts to expose students to choral literature representative of the various historical periods and different musical cultures of the world. The program this evening will include selections from German, English, Italian, Russian, Dutch, Spanish, Norwegian, Israeli, and American composers. It is hoped that the music performed will help cultivate a mutual respect and understanding for the music of the composers and the countries they represent on the part of the students and the listening audience.

O Day Full of Grace is being performed by the **Concert Choir** this evening to celebrate the beginning of a series of concerts to commemorate the 125th birth anniversary of **F. Melius Christiansen**. He was not only the founder of the famous St. Olaf Choir, but is considered to be the pioneer of a cappella choral singing in America. These concerts will culminate with the 1996 anniversary concert on November 16, 17, 1996 at St. Olaf College. For the first time in history, the choirs of Augsburg, Concordia-Moorhead, Gustavus Adolphus, Luther, and St. Olaf will perform together. Several Edina Choir students attending these colleges will be performing in this special concert. If you are interested in tickets, contact Dr. Peterson at the High School.

The **Concert Choir** was invited to the St. Olaf Choral Festival last month to perform as a solo choir, and will be performing at the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C. in April.
