She is currently finishing a licensure program in choral music education from Macalester College. As a part of this program, Martha has expanded her duties at Edina High School by student teaching in the Vocal Music Department. She has studied composition with Nadia Boulanger and Karel Husa, and choral conducting with Dr. Karle Erickson. She has recently become a published composer. The *Adoro te Devote* being performed by the Concert Choir this evening is one of these pieces. This is her third year as the accompanist for all choirs at EHS.

## PROGRAM NOTES

The annual Masterworks Concert features primarily the music of master composers from the various periods of musical history. We also attempt to include examples of folk music from several countries. We hope you enjoy the variety of selections on the program this evening.

The Requiem by John Rutter was written in 1985 and first performed in October of that year. The text comes from the liturgy of the funeral mass. Like Brahms and Faure, the Requiem does not follow the setting strictly. It is made up of some personal texts selections, including the Requiem Mass and The Book of Common Prayer (1662). The romantic theme of the first movement is restated in the *Lux Aeterna*. A special thank you to the Edina Concert Orchestra and their director, DeVonna Murrin. The Requiem will also be performed at the Orchestra Concert on March 17.

The senior soloists performing tonight were selected through audition. Over 120 students are taking private lessons at Edina High School this year. These lessons and the staff of excellent private teachers are extremely important to our program and the individual growth of our students. A special thanks to the parents and students that support this program, and to the wonderful staff of private voice teachers in Edina.
