He was the assistant conductor for the University of Minnesota's Men's and Women's Chorus last year. David currently serves as Senior Choir Director for Clark Memorial U.C.C. in South St. Paul. David will be conducting the **Concert Choir** in *Kas Tie Tadi*, and the **Treble Singers** in *Oh, Dear! What Can the Matter Be?*

The senior soloists performing tonight were selected through audition. Over 120 students are taking private lessons at Edina High School this year. These lessons and the staff of excellent private teachers are extremely important to our program and the individual growth of our students. A special thanks to the parents and students that support this program, and to the wonderful staff of private voice teachers in Edina.

PROGRAM NOTES

The Choral Music Department of Edina Senior High School attempts to expose students to choral literature representative of the various historical periods and different musical cultures of the world. The program this evening will include selections from German, English, Italian, Haidan, Russian, Latvian, Korean, Dutch, Spanish, Swedish, and American composers. It is hoped that the music performed will help cultivate a mutual respect and understanding for the music of the composers and the countries they represent on the part of the students and the listening audience.

The Varsity Choir's opening selection is a love song of the Haida Indian Tribes of Western Canada. The song mourns the loss of a love that has gone away. *De Amor* cautions one not to fall in love, because it only leads to misery and confusion. The Varsity Choir closes with *O Sinfuni Mungu*. A piece from the BembeTribe, Zaire, Africa, which is based on writings of St. Francis of Assisi.

The Concert Choir is preparing for their spring concert tour to Washington, D.C. They will be performing major concerts at the Washington National Cathedral and the Basilica Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. They will also be performing at the U.S. Senate Russell Rotunda for our policalatal leaders. Sight-seeing activities include a private tour of the famous Holocaust Museum. Tour dates are April 18-21, 1996.
