



ans Day assembly. She will attend and swim at UCLA next year.



and all the good times caroling. She plans to study music education and French at Concordia College in Moorhead.





Cassie Michel played Varsity Soccer for three years, and her favorite choir memory is Current Jam junior year. She will be attending the University of San Diego.




