# about 955a & 9TTB Choirs:

All EHS ninth grade students who take choir are in either our 9SSA or 9TTB Choirs. There is no audition required to be a member of these ensembles. Instead, students of all abilities, backgrounds, and all levels of singing experience come together to begin their four-year journey as members of Edina High School Choirs!

The names of the choirs are taken from common designations of choral music: SSA is for treble voices, meaning Soprano 1, Soprano 2, and Alto; TTB stands for Tenor 1, Tenor 2, and Bass. However, it's important to remember that the human voice develops and changes well into a person's twenties. Typically after several years in high school choirs, our students will have sung multiple voice parts!
